With the CDC restrictions in place, camp would not be the same environment that the children have come to know and love. The health and safety of our campers, staff and families has always been our number one priority and it will always be.

This summer will be a difficult one for everyone but please know that Twin Oaks is your forever family. We want to stay connected with you and plan on doing so in ways we never have. We will keep the Twin Oaks Day Camp Spirit alive just as we have for the past 45 summers! Stay tuned for things we are planning. We will also have plenty of time to plan and create so that when we walk through those gates for summer 2021, it will truly be our best summer yet!

Lastly, we are developing a plan for refunds. This information will be sent to you in a separate email at the end of next week.
